## Founder President's Message



I am writing this when the world is limping back after the Covid pandemic. The last three years have turned out to be one of the most challenging years. Very few of us alive today have been through anything like what we have in the past three years.

We all know how it's affected our lives, loved ones, jobs, communities, country, and even the world. Naturally, it has affected sports and games as well. Thanks to the pandemic, even the Tokyo Olympics 2020 had to be postponed.

As President of SAI TGC, my major worry was how this pandemic would affect the ambitious course up-gradation work that SAI undertook. Questions like whether the up-gradation work will face stumbling blocks in its implementation, whether SAI will be able to overcome these, and whether the club will remain closed till the pandemic gets over were echoed repeatedly.

Mind you, this situation had arisen at a time when consistent steps were taken to build a sound financial base for our club. All the statutory dues were paid without fail, and the accounts were audited. For many golf courses, the loss of revenue for almost three years could negatively impact their long-term sustainability. But, with astute planning and tight financial control, we have kept unnecessary expenditure in check and created new sources of revenue that enabled us to swell our fixed deposits to nearly Rs 3 crores by the end of the last financial year. The many facilities you see around the club result from our combined efforts.

Will there be a net gain or loss in the number of golfers during and after the pandemic? I believe this could go either way. Some golf courses in the north saw a record number of rounds during the pandemic because golf courses were deemed essential and stayed open with many social distancing practices.

Some people are chomping at the bit to get out and play, while others considering taking up the game may decide not to. Growing the game is still a high priority for all golfers and is necessary for the good of our nascent sports industry. We need to continue to do everything we can to gain and retain golfers for long-term sustainability.

With this in mind, we vigorously campaigned for Govt of India's assistance in promoting 'Golf Tourism.' We had two objectives in mind: First, upgrade the existing facilities in the Golf course; and, second, lure foreign tourists frequenting the 'God's Own Country' to come and play in the Golf club. Our efforts to convince the Govt of India of the efficacy of this plan bore fruits when the Tourism Ministry of Govt of India decided to sanction an amount of Rs 2464.99 lakhs on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017.



This was the first time the Tourism Ministry granted such an amount to promote 'Golf Tourism.' Sports Authority of India (SAI) was made the implementing agency. They entrusted the work to the CPWD, who awarded it to the lowest bidder after floating tenders. The expertise available in the club was never utilized. Initially, they formed a Monitoring Committee minus representatives of the club. This was rectified later, but the Monitoring Committee has never met to date! The lack of interest shown by the concerned officers of SAI, who were more worried about risk aversion, resulted in the non-utilization of the entire amount sanctioned by the Govt of India. Had SAI taken bold and sure steps and not dragged their feet, the State of Kerala would have got a world-class golf infra in the country. A system that promotes mediocrity and risk aversion rather than innovation and change is destined to spell doom.

As I look back, I feel both satisfied and disheartened. Satisfied because we could rescue the club from near extinction. Dis-heartened because the ambitious plan to upgrade the course was scuttled by some elements suffering from myopia. The entire blame was put on the coronavirus! I am sure the never-say-die spirit of the golfers will overcome all these setbacks and take the club to loftier levels.

Soon, a new Governing Body will take over the reins of SAITGC. While I welcome the new team, let me take this opportunity to thank all the fellow golfers and members of the Governing Body for extending their unstinted support. Because of this spirit, the Trivandrum Golf Club rose from its ashes like the proverbial phoenix bird.

Green stretches, white balls, and smartly dressed humans on the golf course make it a delight to the eyes. Let this delight continue forever and ever!

## **MINUTES OF THE 4th ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF THE SAI TRIVANDRUM GOLF CLUB HELD ON SUNDAY THE 30th JUNE 2019 AT 6:30 PM**

As scheduled the 4th Annual General Body Meeting commenced at 6:30 pm with sufficient quorum. Shri Jiji Thomson IAS (Retd.), President of SAI TGC welcomed all the 62 Members who were present in the AGM.

The Meeting commenced after observing a minute's silence to the memories of the Late KPK Nair, Late Mary Kutty Jacob, Late S.Padmakumar IAS (Retd.), Late V. Sreedharan, Late Dr. D Babu Paul IAS (Retd.), Late P.M Abraham IAS (Retd.), Late Col. K.G Varghese (Retd.).

1) Notice of the 4th AGM was read out and recorded.

Secretary, Shri SN Raghuchandran Nair read out and recorded the Notice of the 4th AGM.

2) Minutes of the 3rd Annual General Body Meeting held on 24th June 2018

The Minutes of the 3rd Annual General Body Meeting was taken as read and passed.

3) Presentation and adoption of Annual Report and Audited Statement of Accounts for the year ending 2018-19

- a) The Annual Report and Audited Statement of Accounts for the year ending 2018-19 was presented by the President and Secretary, which was passed.
- b) Review of the Budget against Actual for the Golfing Year 2018-19 and the Budget for the Golfing Year 2019-20, was approved and passed.

4) Captain's Report

Captain's Report was taken as read in the absence of the Captain Lt. Col. Vasant Kumar.

5) Review of the Facilities and Future Plans

President reviewed the facilities and future plans of the Golf Course. He revealed the delay of Up-gradation works in detail and pipe laying works to the sump.

Shri. Primjithlal of SAI inform that, SAI is yet to initiate a Tender process through CPWD for the Course Up-gradation work.

Secretary briefed about the Up-gradation Meeting held on 24.04.2019 at SAI TGC, when Shri. Vijit Nandrajog, Golf Consultant gave a Power Point presentation of the concept plan submitted by him to the CPWD for the Up-gradation of the Golf Course. They have also minuted our suggestions in the Up-gradation meeting.

President read out the Minutes of the 6th Apex Committee Meeting held on 9th April 2019 wherein, a Monitoring Committee with representatives of SAI TGC should be constituted for overseeing and monitoring the operations of the Up-gradation works including a Swimming Pool to be constructed near the existing Tennis Courts with a roof as part of the Up-gradation process.

AGM discussed the Up-gradation work in detail and the queries raised by the Members were replied to by the Secretary.

Secretary also informed the General Body that, the Apex Committee has authorized SAI TGC to proceed with the formalities for obtaining the Bar Licence. As such, we have already submitted the Application and need to submit some additional relevant documents as required by the Excise Department.

Secretary also informed that a Store Room and one additional room for FL4A Licence will be made ready adjacent to the massage room and the gazebo will be converted into a room respectively.

7) Resolutions

The Secretary informed that two Resolutions have been received within the prescribed time limit and are as follow: -

Moved by Shri. A Gopi Mohan Nair and Dr. Arun Udayabhanu

Resolution No.1 for change of Golf Captain every year to incorporate new ideas every year.  
Resolution No.2 regarding the Waving of rental for the lockers.

After discussions, the General Body unanimously rejected both the Resolutions.

8) Any other Matter with the permission of the Chair

Secretary presented the current running status of National Golf Academy and issues created by the Parents Coach Trainees Association (PCTA).

Secretary also informed the baseless complaints raised by PCTA against SAI TGC, which is submitted to the Sports and Youth Affairs Department of the State Govt.

President replied that all these issues have been informed to the DG SAI and also discussed in the last Apex Committee. DG SAI assured that these activities of parents will not be promoted or tolerated by SAI hereafter.

The Meeting ended at 7:20 pm with thanks to the Chair and to the Members.

1. We have great pleasure in presenting the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Report on the Activities and the Audited Accounts of SAI Trivandrum Golf Club for the years 2019-'20 , 2020 - 2021, 2021 - 22 after resumption of normalcy.  
This Report covers the aspects relating to all the above periods. Annual General Body Meeting in June 2020 and June 2021 could not be conducted on account of the restrictions in forced by the Govt. on account of the Covid Pandemic.
2. SAITGC Governing Body met 4 times during the above said periods .
3. During this period we have been able to prevail over KWA to settle the long pending dispute on the arrear payment of water charges amounting to Rs. 10.23 crores due from 1999 to 25-06-2010 which includes the periods of The Trivandrum Golf Club (TGC). On account of this, our two water connections were disconnected and the remaining one could not be restored. Finally we were able to settle the matter for Rs. 4008829/- out of which ,TGC remitted Rs. 3692309/- and SAI TGC Rs.316520/- Consequently, the only water connection has been restored.

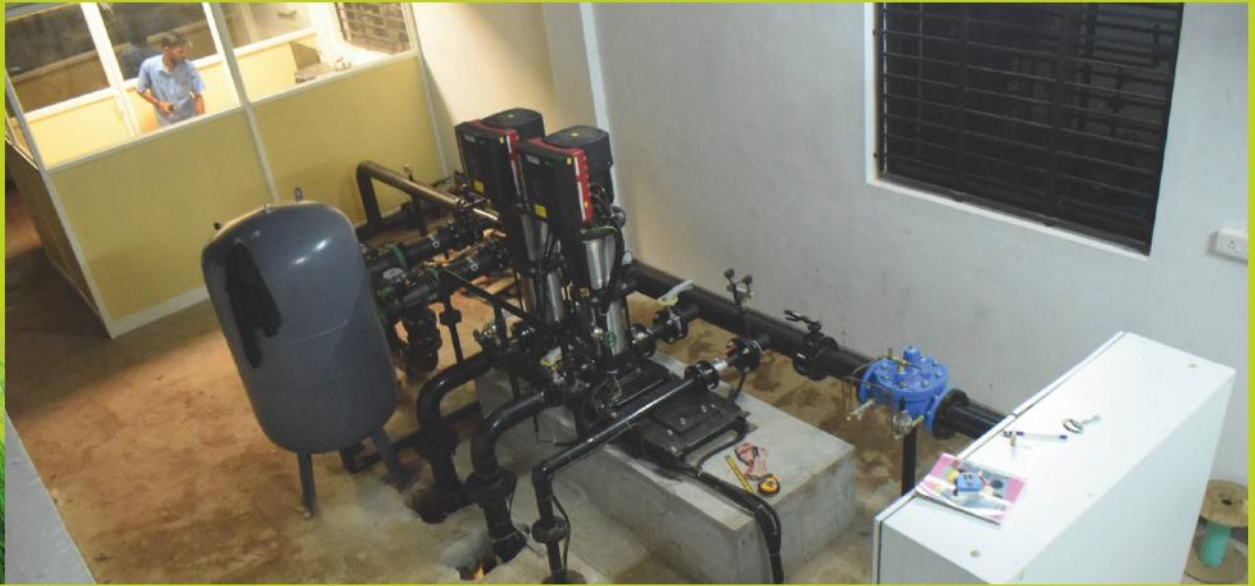

During the Financial Year 2019-20, the Club had a total income of Rs. 79,07,944.95 (Seventy Nine Lakh Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Four Rupees and Ninety Five Paise Only) and total expenditure of Rs. 89,11,776.09 (Eighty Nine Lakh Eleven Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Six Rupees and Nine Paise Only) resulting a net deficit of Rs. 10,03,831.14 (Ten Lakh Three Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty One Rupees and Fourteen Paise Only). Out of this total deficit, deficit before depreciation is Rs. 53,365.00 (Fifty Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Five Rupees and Zero Paise Only) and depreciation is Rs. 9,50,466.14 (Nine Lakh Fifty Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Six Rupees and Fourteen Paise Only).

#### **Opinion**

We have audited the financial statements of **M/s SAI TRIVANDRUM GOLF CLUB** ("the Club"), which comprise the balance sheet as at 31st March 2020, the Income and Expenditure account for the year then ended and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid financial statements gives a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Club as at March 31, 2020, and excess of expenditure over income for the year ended on that date.

#### **Basis for Opinion**

The Club's Board of Members is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position and financial performance in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Governing Act and Bye Laws of the Club for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the Board of Members is responsible for assessing the Club's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Members either intends to discharge the Club or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards. From the matters communicated with those charged with governance, we determine those matters that were of most significance in the audit of the financial statements of the current period and are therefore the key audit matters. We describe these matters in our auditor's report unless law or regulation precludes public disclosure about the matter or when, in extremely rare circumstances, we determine that a matter should not be communicated in our report because the adverse consequences of doing so would reasonably be expected to outweigh the public interest benefits of such communication.

#### **Other Matter**

The Club has not maintaining proper fixed asset register showing full particulars, including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets.

**1. Significant Accounting Policies**

**a. Basis of preparation of Financial Statement.**

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles followed in India. All income and expenses to the extent considered receivable / payable with reasonable certainty are accounted for on accrual basis.

**b. Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements requires estimates and assumptions to be made that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities as on the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenue and expenses during the reported period. The difference between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the period in which the results are known / materialized.

**c. Fixed Assets and Depreciation**

Fixed Assets are stated at historical cost less depreciation. Depreciation on Fixed Assets has been provided on the basis of WDV Method.

The below fixed assets of W.D.V as per the books of accounts of Trivandrum Golf Club as at 31.03.2016, are presently being used by the SAI Trivandrum Golf Club. However, the fixed assets are still not transferred to the books of accounts of SAI Trivandrum Golf Club, since after the discussions with Sports Authority of India as per the AGM held on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

The Club has received demand notice for Rs.5,56,572/- against the assessed income of Rs.14,81,705/- for assessment year 2016-17 as per Order No. ITBA/AST/S/143(3)/2018-19/1014573263(1) dtd. 26.12.2018 from Income Tax Authorities by treating the assessee as an AOP. The Club has filed an appeal against this order in CIT(A), Thiruvananthapuram vide Acknowledgement No. 412802560250119 dtd.25.01.2019 by paying Rs.1,20,000/- as 20% (approximate) of demanded amount.

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Governing Act and Bye Laws of the Club for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the Board of Members is responsible for assessing the Club's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Members either intends to discharge the Club or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

#### **Other Matter**

The Club has not maintaining proper fixed asset register showing full particulars, including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets.

**1. Significant Accounting Policies**

**a. Basis of preparation of Financial Statement.**

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles followed in India. All income and expenses to the extent considered receivable / payable with reasonable certainty are accounted for on accrual basis.

**b. Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements requires estimates and assumptions to be made that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities as on the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenue and expenses during the reported period. The difference between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the period in which the results are known / materialized.

**c. Fixed Assets and Depreciation**

Fixed Assets are stated at historical cost less depreciation. Depreciation on Fixed Assets has been provided on the basis of WDV Method.

The below fixed assets of W.D.V as per the books of accounts of Trivandrum Golf Club as at 31.03.2016, are presently being used by the SAI Trivandrum Golf Club. However, the fixed assets are still not transferred to the books of accounts of SAI Trivandrum Golf Club, since after the discussions with Sports Authority of India as per the AGM held on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

**1. Significant Accounting Policies**

**a. Basis of preparation of Financial Statement.**

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles followed in India. All income and expenses to the extent considered receivable / payable with reasonable certainty are accounted for on accrual basis.

**b. Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements requires estimates and assumptions to be made that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities as on the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenue and expenses during the reported period. The difference between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the period in which the results are known / materialized.

**c. Fixed Assets and Depreciation**

Fixed Assets are stated at historical cost less depreciation. Depreciation on Fixed Assets has been provided on the basis of WDV Method.

The below fixed assets of W.D.V as per the books of accounts of Trivandrum Golf Club as at 31.03.2016, are presently being used by the SAI Trivandrum Golf Club. However, the fixed assets are still not transferred to the books of accounts of SAI Trivandrum Golf Club, since after the discussions with Sports Authority of India as per the AGM held on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

## Captain's Report



**Dear Golfers,**

1. It is a great privilege and honour for me to present my report of SAI Trivandrum Golf Club for the Golfing calendar year 2019-2020.
2. During the last golfing year we had conducted all the scheduled 19 tournaments where as this year the unexpected Covid pandemic led to many restrictions which have forced us to cancel five of the scheduled tournaments. Cancelled tournaments were Governors Cup, Army Cup, Dr Prasannan Memorial Cup, G Bhaskaran Nair Memorial Cup and Presidents Cup. Like last year we had an average participation of 20 golfers for the in house tournaments this year.

### **Major Sponsored Tournaments**

3. **Petronet LNG Cup.** We have succeeded in conducting this tournament in a grand manner on 18 Jan 2020. Due to unforeseen circumstances this cup was not held during the previous year. Possibility of reviving this tournament was passed on to me by golfer Mr. Subramonian MR. On contacting Mr. TN Neelakantan, Senior VP (Plant Head) Petronet LNG, he readily agreed to sponsor the tournament. The tournament was held in a befitting manner with a participation of 65 golfers. Dinner cum prize distribution was held at Hotel South Park with the participation of more than 60 golfers including ladies. I take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude to Mr. TN Neelakantan, chief guest, for his approval to conduct this tournament just before his retirement. We look forward to our brothers in arms for their continued support, like many previous years, for holding this tournament without any break in future too. Mr. Alex P Antony who won the Southern Air Command Cup received the coveted trophy from its Commander in Chief Air Marshal Amit Tiwari AVSM, VM.

### **Trivandrum Addicts Meet**

6. Addicts Golfing Society of Southern India's Trivandrum Addicts Meet was held on 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> January 2020. There was an increase of seven golfers from the out station participants of 18, compared to the previous year which was 11. I am happy to inform you all that out of the total 65 participants, a majority of 46 were from SAI TGC.



Total conduct of the meet was parexcellence, with the 11<sup>th</sup> January dinner being held at Hotel South Park. Prize distribution, closing ceremony and lunch were held at our club on 12<sup>th</sup> January afternoon. Our addicts' performance during this meet deserves a standing ovation with 15 prizes (winners plus runner ups) being won out of 17 listed prizes. I thank everyone who was involved in making this meet a super success

### **Covid 19 and Golfing**

7. Everything was going on so smoothly with excellent weather, more than adequate showers to keep the course green and enviable, tournaments were being held on schedule as per the calendar and the course was adequately filled with both morning and afternoon golfers. Suddenly this pandemic, worst in the history of our mankind in general and our generation in particular, has descended heavily on us shattering the aspirations of every one in every field. Golf was no exception. The course closed down for the first time on 22 March 2020 and never opened for any activity till the current golfing calendar year got over. Fear of uncertain future, imminent death, crippling economy, loss of job, quarantined life devoid of any entertainment and social engagement made us realize that worse is yet to come. One thing we were sure was that it was not going to be a permanent scenario. We would have to get back to our golden days and that it would happen soon, I was sure.

### **Caddies Sustenance Fund**

8. Our caddies were the worst affected during this pandemic period neither having a steady income nor an opportunity to work anywhere. 111 golfers with handicap had agreed to contribute to one month's sustenance allowance based on the caddies attendance and contributed Rs. 63960 to this effect. Since the lock down got extended, another month's sustenance allowance was paid from the fund available with the erstwhile Trivandrum Golf club. In addition to this, a final one time allowance was also given to the affected caddies making it a total of two and a half months sustenance allowance. Total golfers contribution was Rs. 73125 and TGC Rs. 77480. Though this was not a major assistance, it did help our caddies to tide over the difficult times. I thank our dear golfers, President, Secretary and Treasurer of TGC Mr. B Ramdas, Mr. SN Raghuchandran Nair and Mr. K Thomas Jacob respectively for their timely support.



### **Golfing Out**

9. Golfing out of our only lady temporary member Mrs. Neeta Gilganchi was held on 8 Feb 2020 with high tea and presentation of a memento. She was getting back to Bangalore permanently. We wish her all the best for her golfing days at Bangalore.

### **Hole in One**

10. Compared to seven in the previous year, the current year witnessed only two hole in ones, by Col Jaya Kumar (14 Jan 2020/5<sup>th</sup> hole) and Col RC Mohanan (09 Mar 2020/4<sup>th</sup> hole)

### **Course Upgradation**

11. There is no worthwhile progress on this front except for the fact that a few meetings were held to speed up the process of tendering. No tender was placed so far which, I am sure, will materialize soon. Our dream of having a world class golf course in SAI TGC will hopefully become a reality soon.

### **Obituary**

12. Eight of our dear golfers left us for the heavenly abode. These were Shri. George Varghese, Mr. Chitambaram P, Mr. Dileep Mohan, Capt Harinarayanakumaran Nair, Mr. Prasad C Nainan, Mr. Rajeevan VR (IPS), Mr Chacko Varghese, and Mr. Jacob Koshy Madhavana . We will definitely miss them. We pray that their souls rest in peace.

### **Retirement**

13. Our ground maintenance staff Gopi B retired from service on 31 Oct 2019 after attaining the age of retirement. We wish him all the very best in his retired life.
